

FY23 ANNUAL REPORT

Summary

- FY23 call volume 1769, an increase of 74 calls from FY22.
- We completed second phase of our Medicare Audit on 6/27/23 with a claim error rate of 0.00%.
- All staff completed the Certified Ambulance Documentation Specialist (CADS) certification as part of the Medicare Audit training.
- We migrated all our policies to the county website in September 2022.
- An Employee Assistance Program (EAP) was implemented in October 2022.
- A county-wide Active Shooter Exercise was held in North English in September 2022.
- The Iowa County EMS Advisory Council held their inaugural meeting in December 2022.
- A Narcan program for our First Responder teams was implemented in January 2022.
- All county EMS services had State inspections in February 2022 and were re-authorized for another 3 years.
- We took delivery of a new 2023 Lifeline Ambulance in April 2023.

Challenges

- Increasing call volume frequently stresses our resources. In October 2022 dispatch started tracking how often we request outside ambulance services to cover our calls. This data will help us evaluate our future staffing needs.
- Recruiting and retention of both volunteer and paid EMS providers is an ongoing challenge.
 Employee turnover is trending down since implementation of a new wage scale in FY22 and the free family health insurance offered in FY23.
- Facilities: With increasing call volume we need to keep additional supplies on hand and finding storage is a challenge. As we grow staffing to keep up with increased demand, we will need additional space.
- Medication Shortages: We continue to struggle to obtain some medications because they are not available from distributors. Unfortunately, this has not recovered from Covid like we had hoped.




- Maintain patient satisfaction at 96% or greater measured by patient surveys: 98.25%.

- ➤ A 12-Lead EKG will be completed within 10 minutes of arrival on scene when chief complaint is Chest Pain: 11 min. 25s.


