The total integration of equal opportunity into all parts of personnel and program management is the Chief Elected Official's responsibility. The Chief Elected Official will review all policies and procedures as they affect equal opportunity and affirmative action and ensure compliance with relevant federal and state statutes.

The right of appeal and recourse is guaranteed by the Local Government. Purpose of this policy is to ensure that sound business judgment is utilized in all procurement transactions and that supplies, equipment, construction, and services are obtained efficiently and economically and in compliance with applicable federal law and executive orders and to ensure that all procurement transactions will be conducted in a manner that provides full and open competition.

## APPLICATION

This policy applies to the procurement of all supplies, equipment, construction, and services of and for the local government related to the implementation and administration of the Community Development Block Grant. All procurement will be done in accordance with 24 CRF; Part 85.

### POLICY

### I. Methods of procurement

Procurement under grants shall be made by one of the following methods, as described herein; (a) small purchase procedures; (b) sealed bids (formal advertising); (c) competitive proposals; (d) non-competitive proposals.

**A.** Small purchase procedures are relatively simple and informal procurement methods that sound and appropriate for a procurement of services, supplies, or other property, costing in aggregate not more than \$100,000. If small purchase procedures are used for a procurement under a grant, price or rate quotations shall be obtained from an adequate number of qualified sources to determine the most advantageous provider.

**B**. In sealed bids (formal advertising), sealed bids are publicly solicited and a firm fixed price contract (lump sum or unit price) is awarded to the responsible bidder whose bid conforming with all of the material terms and conditions of the invitation for bids, is lowest in price. The sealed bids methods is the preferred method for procuring construction.

In order for formal advertising to be feasible, the following conditions must be present:
(a) A complete, adequate and realistic specification or purchase description;

(b) two or more responsible suppliers are willing and able to compete effectively for the business; and

(c) the procurement lends itself to a firm fixed price contract, and selection of a successful bidder can appropriately be made principally on the basis of price.

2. When the formal advertising is used for a procurement under a grant, the following requirements shall apply:

(a) The invitation for bids will be publicly advertised and bids shall be solicited from an adequate number of known suppliers.

(b) The invitation for bids, including specifications and pertinent attachments, shall clearly define the items or services needed in order for the bidders to properly respond to the invitation.

(c) All bids shall be opened publicly at the time and place stated in the invitation for bids. (d) A firm fixed price contract award shall be made be written notice to that responsible bidder whose bid, conforming to the invitation for bids, is lowest. Where specified in the bidding documents, factors such as discounts, transportation costs and life cycle costs shall be considered in deterring which bid is lowest. Payment discounts may only be used to determine low bid when prior experience of the Local Government indicated that such discounts are generally taken.

(e) Any or all bids may be rejected when there are sound documented business reasons in the best interest of the program.

**C.** In competitive proposals, proposals are requested from a number of sources and the Request for Proposal is publicized. Negotiations are normally conducted with more than one of the sources submitting offers, and either a fixed price or cost reimbursable type contract is awarded, as appropriate for the use of formal advertising. If the competitive proposals method is used for a procurement under a grant, the following requirements shall apply:

1. The Request for Proposal shall be publicized and identify all evaluation factors and their relative importance. Any response to publicized request for proposals shall be honored to the maximum extent practical.

2. Requests for proposals shall be solicited from an adequate number of qualified sources. 3. The local government shall provide mechanisms for technical evaluation of the proposals received, determinations of responsible offers for the purpose of written or oral discussions, and selection for contract award.

4. Awards will be made to the responsible offerer whose proposal will be most advantageous to the procuring party, with price and other factors considered. Unsuccessful offers will be promptly notified in writing.

5. The local government may utilize competitive negotiation procedures for procurement of architectural/engineering(A/E) professional services, whereby competitor's qualifications are selected, subject to negotiation of fair and reasonable compensation. The methods, where price is not used as a selection factor, can only be used in the procurement of A/E professional services. It can not be used to procure other types of sources (e.g. administration professional services) even though A/E firms are a potential source to perform the proposed effort.

**D.** Noncompetitive proposals are procured through solicitation of a proposal from only one source, or after solicitation of a number of sources, competition is determined inadequate. Noncompetitive proposals may be used only when the award of a contract is not feasible under small purchase, sealed bids(formal advertising), or competitive proposals. Circumstances under which a contract may be awarded by noncompetitive proposals are limited to the following:

1. The item is available from only a single source;

2. After solicitation of a number of sources; competition is determined inadequate;

3. A public urgency or emergency when the urgency for the requirement will not permit a delay incident to competitive solicitation; and 4

4. The awarding agency (IDED) authorizes non competitive proposals. (Sole source procurement for supplies, equipment, construction, and services valued at \$25,000 or more must have prior approval of the Iowa Department of Economic Development.)

**E.** The Local Government will provide, to the greatest extent possible, that contracts be awarded to qualified small and minority firms, women's business enterprises, and labor surplus area firms whenever they are potential sources.

**F.** Any other method of procurement must have prior approval from the Iowa Department of Economic Development.

## **II.** Contract Pricing

**A.** The cost plus a percentage of cost and percentage of construction cost method or contracting shall not be used.

**B.** The Local Government shall perform some form of cost/price analysis for every procurement action, including modifications or change orders.

The Local Government shall maintain records sufficient to detail the significant history of a procurement, including the rationale for the method of procurement, selection of contract type, contractor selection or rejection, and the basis for the contract price. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Jindrich seconded by Caes to approve and authorize the chair to sign the following resolution: **WHEREAS:** Iowa County, Iowa henceforth referred to as the local government, will replace all occupied and vacant occupiable low/moderate-income dwelling units demolished or converted to a use other than low/moderate-income housing in connection with an activity assisted with funds provided under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, in accordance with the requirements described in 24 CFR 570.496(c)(1).

All replacement housing will be provided within three years after the commencement of the demolition or conversion. Before entering into a contract committing the Local Government to provide funds for an activity that will directly result in demolition or conversion, the Local Government will make public by publication in a paper of general circulation and submit to the Iowa Department of Economic Development the following information in writing:

1. A description of the proposed activity.

The exact location on a map (including addresses) and the exact number of dwelling units by size (number of bedrooms) that will be demolished or converted to a use other than low/moderate-income dwelling units as a direct result of the essential activity;
A time schedule for the commencement and completion of the demolition or conversion;

4. The exact location on a map and exact number of dwelling units that will be provided as replacement dwelling units. If such data are not available at the time of the general submission, the Local Government will identify the general location on an area map and the approximate number of dwelling units by size and provide information identifying the specific location and number of dwelling units by size as soon as it is available;

5. The source of funding and a time schedule for the provision of replacement dwelling units;

6. The basis for concluding that each replacement dwelling unit will remain a low/moderate-income dwelling unit for a least ten (10) years from the date of initial occupancy, and;

7. Information demonstrating that any proposed replacement of dwelling units with smaller dwelling units is consistent with the housing needs of low/moderate-income

households in the jurisdiction.

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors, Iowa County Courthouse, Marengo, Iowa 52301, telephone (319)642-3041 is responsible for tracking the replacement of housing and ensuring that it is provided within the required period.

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors, Iowa County Courthouse, Marengo, Iowa 52301, telephone (319)642-3041 is responsible for ensuring requirements are met for notification an provision of relocation assistance, as described in CFR 570.496(a)(c)(2), to any low/moderate-income person displace by the demolition of any dwelling unit or the conversion of a low/moderate-income dwelling unit to another use in connection with an assisted activity.

Consistent with the goals and objectives of activities assisted under the Act, the Local Government will take the following steps to minimize the displacement of persons from their homes:

1. Evaluate housing codes and rehabilitation standards in reinvestment areas to prevent their placing undue financial burden on established owners or tenants of multi-family buildings.

2. Establish facilities to house persons who must be relocated temporarily during rehabilitation.

3. Adopt policies which protest tenants from developers that would rehabilitate housing in such a manner that it would no longer be affordable to low/moderate-income families or individuals.

4. Establish counseling centers to provide homeowners and renters with information on the assistance available to help them remain in their neighborhood in the face of revitalization or rehabilitation efforts.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Local Government will provide relocation assistance as described by 49 CRF 24, Subplots C. D, and E or 24 CFR 570.496a(E)(2), whichever is applicable, to each low/moderate-income dwelling to another use as a direct result of assisted activities. All aye, motion carried.

## **RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR A ROAD RESURFACING POLICY FOR RESIDENTS REQUESTING A PRIVATE AGREEMENT**

Whereas, some residents in the unincorporated area of Iowa County, Iowa have requested an oil seal coat surface past their property; and

Wereas, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors want to provide a policy to accomplish this goal; and

Whereas, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors is offering a program to residents of Iowa County and homeowners to purchase oil seal coat surfaces on county roads adjacent to their property without a change in the present road classification. Iowa County will rock the road to furnish a good base prior to seal coating. The program for the first year includes a double seal coat consisting of primer and two coats of oil and chips as per Iowa Department of Transportation current specifications as approved by the Iowa County Engineer. The third year will be a single seal coat. Quotes for the work to be done will be obtained by the Iowa County Engineer at which time the residents will be advised of the cost. The residents will then individually and in whole pay the Iowa County Engineer's office in advance their equal share of the cost of said work.

## **PROCEDURES:**

A. At such time as the Iowa County Engineer's office receives full payment for the current project, the contractor will be given permission to proceed with the work as outlined in this resolution.

B. This policy will apply only to county roads connecting to an oiled road or paved road. Spot requests will not be allowed on gravel roads.

C. Iowa County will impose a weight embargo when necessary and especially during the spring thaw period.

D. The change in surface will not change the priority status of snow removal on these roadways.

E. The maintenance fund, if necessary, is intended for all problems not caused by Iowa County Secondary Roads.

F. Iowa County reserves the right to deny application for this program based on traffic counts, snow drifting problems, future road construction possibilities, structure repairs, heavy truck traffic or other vehicular traffic, or other conditions that the county deems relevant.

G. Iowa County reserves the sole right to determine the required maintenance necessary and to assess the entire cost to the contractee which amount shall be annually estimated and deposited with the engineer on the same basis that the original resurfacing deposit is made.

H. A specific contract between the property owners and Iowa County will be executed with said contract containing specific details of the individual project and the costs associated therewith.
