Old Business

Rescue Building/ EOC Update- Humphrey welcomed everyone to the new facility. He explained that there just a few things that have had to be addressed since moving in. Internet is still temporary and the temperature in the IT room is an issue. He is working to have another thermo sensor installed so that the system will average the temps. The best solution to this would be a mini split to be stand alone and that would be about \$3000. This is one of the things that happens on a spec building. Other than that item everything else is working good and getting up and going.

New Business

CrisisGo for Schools- Humphrey gave the group an update on the project and that all schools are working on implementation so they can use for there staff.

EMA Vehicle- Josh explained that the 5 year mark is here for the EMA Command vehicle and he is requesting the board authorize the chair to sign contract documents for the replacement vehicle when paperwork is completed. Trade in for current vehicle will be \$18000. This would be another 5 year municipal lease like in the past. We would be paying for it starting next budget. Motion by Heitshusen to authorize the chair to sign lease agreement for new vehicle when completed, Seconded by Ward. All Ayes Motion passed. Josh will work to get paperwork completed and to the chair in the coming weeks.

English Valley High School Full Scale Exercise- Humphrey and Sheriff Rotter talked with the board about the exercise. Humphrey confirmed that all members have received the AAR. This was a good exercise and begins our alternating schedule of exercises again.
