

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors met March 14, 2025. Heitshusen, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Heitshusen, Meyer, Degen and Montross were present. Maas was absent.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve** the agenda. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve** minutes for March 7, 2025. All aye, motion carried.

Chair Notes: The board approved handwritten claims paid with warrant numbers 37626 and 37789 and payroll paid with warrant numbers 37627-37788.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve the liquor license** for R & S Enterprises. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Meyer, seconded by Degen to **approve Resolution 2025-03-14** as follows:

Resolution 2025-03-14

AUTHORIZING WEIGHT EMBARGOES ON SECONDARY ROADS

WHEREAS, the recent weather conditions have caused soft subgrade and surface conditions to develop on some Secondary Roads; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best public interest and welfare to preserve the road system in the best possible condition; and

WHEREAS, Sections 321.471, 321.472, and 321.473 of the Code of Iowa provide local authorities the right to restrict the weight of vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that an embargo be authorized where necessary on the Secondary Roads System for Iowa County. The County Engineer is authorized beginning on March 14, 2025, to restrict gross loads on certain sections of the road system showing extreme distress at the time. The Engineer shall be authorized to restrict all traffic to a 10-ton gross load if necessary and to place temporary signs to comply with Section 321.472.

Motion by Meyer, seconded by Degen to **approve the bid from CF Construction** in the amount of \$78,561.01 for 2025 **Spring Pavement Patching**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve low bid** in the amount of \$54,340.00 from LL Pelling for 2025 **Pavement markings**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve the bid** from LL Pelling in the amount of \$166,177.50 for **Lake Iowa Road – G Ave. Chip Seal**. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Degen, seconded by Montross to **adjourn** at 9:54 a.m. All aye, motion carried.
