WHEREAS, Iowa County (“County”) is a member of the Iowa State Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, the ISAC Articles of Incorporation were updated in November 2024 to require the County to designate, through resolution by its Board of Supervisors, its County Voting Representatives; and

WHEREAS, only the designated County Voting Representatives have the power to vote on behalf of the County at ISAC; and

WHEREAS, the County Voting Representatives must be either elected county officials or the principal officer for each county department represented by an Affiliated Association of ISAC.

This letter serves as a notification of a resolution of support by the Board of Supervisors of Iowa County to have the bridge that crosses over Old Man's Creek on Highland Street and State 149 through Williamsburg to be named for Eugene Burton Ely. Ely was born in Williamsburg on October 21, 1886 and is the father of naval aviation. He was the first person to take off from a ship (11/14/1910) and land on a ship (01/18/1911).
