

The Iowa County Board of Supervisors met on September 18, 2026. Heitshusen called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Degen, Heitshusen, Maas, Meyer and Montross were present.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Maas to **approve** the agenda. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to **approve** minutes from September 11, 2026. Ayes, Heitshusen, Maas, Meyer and Montross. Degen, abstained.

Chair notes: The board approved Handwritten Claims paid with warrant numbers 49819 – 49820 and 49960 – 49961 and claims paid with warrant numbers 49821 – 49959. The Board received a Manure Management Plan from Kovar Farms, facility #66956.

Nick Amelon, Iowa County Engineer, met with the board to present the department's weekly update. Discussion regarding the speed limit on M Ave – North out of Marengo, V36 – North out of Victor and 108th and I Ave.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Degen to **pass, adopt and approve Resolution 2026-09-18 for F46 – East out of Williamsburg – 35 mph** as follows:

Resolution 2026-09-18

REDUCE SPEED LIMIT ON F46 (East Side of Williamsburg) TO 35 MPH.

WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285 of the Code of Iowa to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS: approximately 1,000 ft of F46 within the subject area is a shared roadway, between Iowa County and the City of Williamsburg; and

WHEREAS: crash records indicate that five (5) crashes have occurred within this section of roadway during the past ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, this section of F46 contains a reverse curve that affects the safe and reasonable operating speed of vehicles traveling through the area; and

WHEREAS, a ball-bank indicator test was conducted as part of the engineering and traffic investigation, and the results support an advisory and operating speed of approximately 35 miles per hour through the reverse curve; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Engineer has completed an engineering and traffic investigation of this section of roadway and recommends establishing a speed limit of 35 miles per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that a speed limit of 35 miles per hour is hereby established on F46 as follows:

Beginning at the City of Williamsburg corporate limits on F46, as shown on the attached map, and proceeding easterly approximately 2,300 feet, a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour shall be established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriate regulatory speed limit signs shall be erected and maintained in accordance with applicable standards, and that the 35-mile-per-hour speed limit shall become effective upon installation of the appropriate signs.

All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Montross, seconded by Degen to **pass, adopt and approve Resolution 2026-09-18-A for 108th and I Ave** as follows:

Resolution 2026-09-18-A

WHEREAS, The Iowa County Engineer has been asked to investigate the intersection of I Ave, F15 Blvd, and 108th St; and

WHEREAS, The Engineer presented the findings from the investigation to the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the findings followed the guidelines from Section 2B of the MUTCD, the Engineer finds all-way stop controlled intersection is warranted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors personally viewed and evaluated the intersection as part of its consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT:

The Board accepts the Engineer's findings and the County Engineer is instructed to install all necessary stop signs.

All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Maas, seconded by Montross to **approve Certificates of Adjustments** – Corrections being made to statements for Parcel #'s 152003032 and 141902049 due to an Assessor's office oversight. All aye, motion carried.
